- b. Tiger Cubs – Cheryl and JoAnne to do presentation at Hillel/MJDS

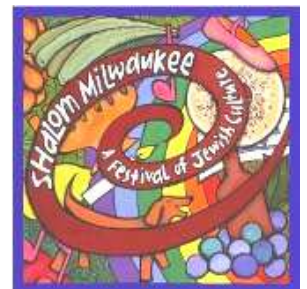
4. Conservation
