A patch around the themes of Jewish history, Jewish resilience, Jewish culture and faith through completing 3-4 activities:

Jewish history and resilience such as “scaling the walls of Jericho with climbing and rappelling,” swimming/ canoe/kayak across the “Reed Sea” (lake), or rifle/archery

Jewish culture and faith such as earning a Jewish emblem, making a handicraft project such as a mezuzah, cooking challah on a stick.

Tikkun Olam projects such as signing new year cards for seniors and Israeli soldiers, putting together Rosh Hoshana packages, and doing a conservation project for the camp.

Exhibit Hall with an NJCOS store, Jewish Emblems, Exhibits and guests from Israeli and Jewish organizations. Game: What's your "JQ?" Prizes too.

Gala campfire programs that includes a Jewish camp singalong, learning some Israeli dances, welcoming Jewish Scouters and perhaps officials from the State of Israel.
